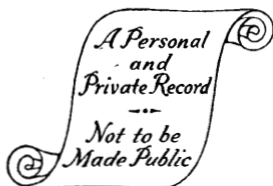


Elder's Achievement Chart

1. I have been elected by a local congregation for years and have been duly installed at a public service.
2. I pray and read my Bible daily that I may "grow in grace and in the knowledge of the truth."
3. I have studied carefully the Scriptural qualifications and duties of an Elder (1 Timothy 3; Titus 1; Acts 20: 17-36; Heb. 13: 7, 17; 1 Peter 5).
4. In my personal, family and business life I allow myself no evil habits or other practices that will interfere with my divinely assigned office, or that will prevent me serving as an Elder in a way acceptable to my Lord.
5. I make it the purpose of my life to win others to Christ and to strengthen and encourage in the faith those already in the church.
6. I attend the Lord's Supper each and every week, and all other church gatherings which I should attend as Elder.
7. At least once each year I read an instructive book, take a training course or otherwise improve myself as an Elder and Christian leader.
8. I study regularly and carefully the literature taught in the local church to make sure that it is "holding fast" the truths of God's Word.
9. I aid my minister in every way to be faithful to the Word of God in his preaching and teaching. I assist in shepherding and guarding the flock so that none shall stray.
10. I help see to it that the Bible school, Christian Endeavor and other educational agencies of the local church are provided with officers and teachers who are true to the Word.
