


1866 PRESENT SUBSCRIBERS WHO HAVE

FOUR only of the original board of stockholders survive. Their portraits appear on this page. They were associated with Thomas W. Phillips, Charles M. Phillips, I. N. Phillips, John T. Phillips, W. J. Ford, James A. Garfield, Isaac Errett, J. H. Rhodes, J. H. Jones, Dr. Thos. L. Bane, A. J. Marvin, Richard Hawley, Dr. J. P. Robison, Harmon Austin, Dr. S. P. Boynton and G. W. N. Yost as the Christian Publishing Association. This association was organized to found the CHRISTIAN STANDARD, and continued its publication at Cleveland, for two years. It then passed into the hands of Isaac Errett, who published it at Alliance, O., for one year, when it was transferred to R. W. Carroll, who published it at Cincinnati till 1873, when he formed The Standard Publishing Co., which has continued the publication in Cincinnati for thirty years.
