## **About NBCC:**

New Brighton Christian Church is a Restoration Church committed to serving God and loving our neighbors. NBCC is located in New Brighton, MN a northern suburb of the Twin Cities.

## **History**:

#### 1958

A vision for a Christian church in New Brighton was driven by several Minnesota Bible College students with the first service held March 9, 1958. Soon afterward, the Bible College student body helped raise funds for the down payment to purchase a small white wooden frame building in downtown New Brighton that would become New Brighton Christian Church.

#### 1969

As the church grew over the next decade, it became obvious more space was needed. Eleven years from the first service held in the original church building, New Brighton Christian Church had the dedication service for a new building at 1500 29<sup>th</sup> Ave. N.W.

#### 1990

In spring of 1990, the congregation voted to approve a plan to add both a 40 foot x 90 foot two story addition plus a 970 square foot one floor addition for office space. Construction was completed that summer and fall.

#### 1958 - Present

During its history, New Brighton Christian Church has had ten Ministers and five Youth/Children's Ministers. Our current minister has served the Lord at New Brighton for 24 years.
